As a firm rule: NO TEAM may have 3 players ranked in the top 2 rounds of the draft, regardless of combination (2,2,2 is no more acceptable than 1,1,1 or 1,2,2)

As a general rule: Most second-yr players will rank somewhere in the top 5-6 rounds

As a general rule: A-team All-Stars who are moving into a new division may rank in the 2nd/3rd/4th round, B-team All-Stars may rank in the 3rd/4th/5th round

As a general rule: Any All-Star who is returning to the same division will automatically rank in the 1st round

If you have a particular DP combination, please present it to Division Directors ASAP, and they'll review it to see if it falls within the range of allowable combinations. They can tell you which range of the grid you'll probably fall in, and from the grid you can then
